We hope everyone had a well-earned holiday that was full of fun and relaxation this autumn. We are forward to another exciting and educational term. Here is a hint as to this term's theme:

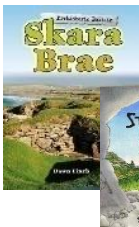
Q: Who did all the counting for the caveman?

What are the children learning in Term 2?



English: This term we will be focusing on the texts: Stone Age Boy by Satoshi Kitamura and Skara Brae by Dawn Finch. Using a variety of conjunctions, adverbs and prepositions to express time and cause and identifying and understanding the main clause in a sentence.

Maths: We will practice numbers up to three digits. Two- and three-digit numbers will be added and subtracted. Next, divide and multiply by 3, 4, and 8. We'll start practising our times tables for twos, fours, and eights.

Music: Play the recorder

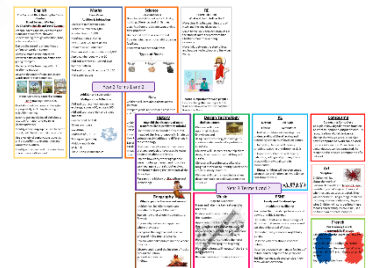
We will learn key features of a recorder, hold and blow correctly, cover holes, create notes B, A, G, play simple tunes with short and long durations, and familiarize ourselves with musical notation.

We'll study animal nutrition, nutrient needs, skeleton types, and muscle function. We'll apply scientific skills to design and conduct an investigation on the human skeleton.
