Dear Year 3 Flamingos,

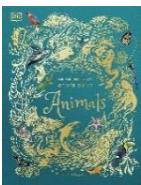
Welcome back after the Christmas holidays. We hope you had a great break and the children have all returned with smiling faces and eager to be at school!

What are the children learning in Term 3?



English: This term we will be focusing on the texts: Flood by Alvaro F. Villav and An Anthology of Animals by Ben Hoare: Skeletons and Muscles. We will be preparing to write a non-chronological report and a tragedy narrative including a number of Year 3 level skills.



Maths: Your child will learn their multiples of 3, 4, 8 & 10. Multiply and divide a 2-digit number by a 1-digit number with no exchanging and then with exchanging. Then, learn to Measure in m, cm & mm. Where they will then compare, add & subtract lengths. Moving on to measuring & calculating perimeter.



Keeping Healthy

This term, children will be learning **Tag rugby** and **yoga**. Teamtheme will be teaching these lessons.

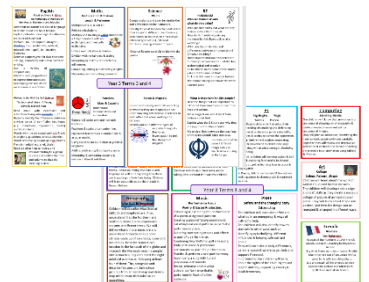
Please make sure PE kits are in school every day



ART: Collage - Colour, Pattern & Shape

The children will continue their French journey by recapping and then moving on to say and match all the animals to their appropriate picture and attempt to spell three animals in French.
