Dear Year 3 Flamingos,

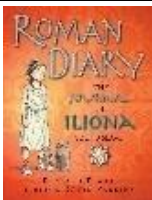
*Welcome back! We hope your break has been relaxing.*

### What are the children learning in Term 4?



**English:** Richard Platt's *The Journal of Iliona: A Young Slave* is one of the pieces we will be studying this term. We'll be practising many Year 3 skills as we get ready to compose a journal entry.

*What did the Romans do for us?*

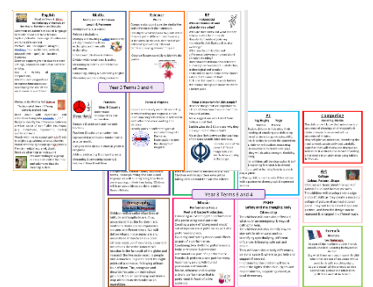
The children will learn about the impact the Romans had on the people of Britain.
