Reading books

Also, we will use laptops to explore data collection and make pictograms as part of our computing lessons. In Science, alongside continuing to head outside and find out about animals and plants in their habitats, we will look closely at animals and humans, life cycles, food chains and how humans keep healthy through diet and cleanliness.

This term, we will also follow our Sex and Relationships curriculum to learn about the differences between male and female body parts and animal babies.
